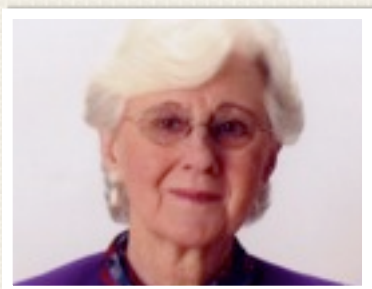
We thank the Lord for the opportunities that we have had to share the ministry of Frontline with local churches in our area. We are amazed to hear what the Lord is
